Limen is a sensory threshold, when something subtle then becomes perceptible. In architecture, it describes a physical or conceptual boundary between distinct spaces. This transitional zone heightens awareness as one moves from one condition to another.

Features include a woven electrical cord, and a two tone dimmer knob controlling both light temperature and brightness
